Knock Programme for Saturday April 20th 2013

Let us pray together and celebrate the Year of Faith in Knock on Saturday April 20th 2013.

- 10.30** Meet in St John's Rest/Care Centre Hall near Basilica
- 10.40** Welcome and Announcements
- 10.50** Talk 1, by Father Michael Ross SDB (in St John's Hall or Basilica, depending on early numbers)
- 11.30** ► **Workshop/activities for Children** * (6 to 12 years old) in Taizé Room in Prayer Guidance Centre. Organised and conducted by Antoinette and her Team
- 12.00** **Angelus.** ► **Children's Adoration in** Taizé Room in Prayer Guidance Centre. **Adults interested in children's Adoration** can see a full session of Children's Adoration in action.
- 11.30** ► **Workshop/Activities/Testimonies** etc for Teens and Young People (in room in St John's Centre). Organised and conducted by Net Ministries
- 11.30** **Meeting and Presentation for the officers** of all Diocesan Adoration Committees (in room in St John's Centre)
- 12.30** **Lunch:** Tea/Coffee in St John's (bring packed lunch); lunches/food also available in Café Le Chéile (extension to Knock Museum Building) and also in local restaurants.
- 13.30** **Talk 2, by Father Michael Ross** SDB, in Basilica or St John's Centre
- 13.30** ► Children continue in same place as morning session. Taizé Room
- 13.30** ► Teens/Young People Continue in same place as morning session
- 14.15** **Free Time:** Prayer/Reflection time/sharing/Adoration/Confessions
- 14.30** **Rehearsals** for all involved in the Mass: Readers, Prayers of the Faithful, Offertory Procession and Children for Children's Adoration
- 14.50** **All assemble** in Basilica in preparation for Holy Mass.
- 15.00** **Holy Mass,** (Meath Diocesan Choir), blessing/anointing of the sick, homily, Children's Adoration (before the Eucharistic Procession, a final word from our Apostolate).
- 16.00** **Eucharistic Procession** from Basilica to Apparition Hill, with Rosary, finishing in the Apparition Chapel for Benediction. **Bring your Parish/Apostolate Banners**

** Children need to be accompanied by teacher or parent or guardian*

Children need written permission of parents/guardians to participate and to have photos/video taken of them engaged in the Adoration activities for children so that we can use it later for the promotion of Children's Adoration.
